Each add on acquisition is highly strategic and builds upon the portfolio companies' growth initiatives.

In April, NDS Surgical Imaging ("NDSsi"), a leading provider of surgical and radiology visualization technology announced the acquisition of Rivulet Communications and the creation of its new Network Visualization (NetViz) Group. With this acquisition, NDSsi will be developing a network product to deliver a compelling high-definition end-to-end solution that will display, stream, capture, archive, and remotely access surgical image data. Rivulet is the third acquisition that Riverside Partners has funded as part of its support of the growth plan at NDSsi.

In May, Alteris Renewables, the largest design-build renewable energy company in the Northeast, acquired ISI Solar of New City, NY. ISI Solar designs and installs solar electric systems for residential and commercial customers in New York and New Jersey. The acquisition of ISI Solar is the second add on backed by Riverside Partners for Alteris during the past year, furthering the company's mission to bring quality, affordable renewable energy systems to homeowners, businesses and schools in the Northeast United States.

GEMcity Engineering and Manufacturing, a leading provider of complex electromechanical and component engineering and manufacturing services, acquired Vistek Medical ("Vistek") in May. Vistek, based in Pennsylvania, provides highly specialized outsourced manufacturing services to the medical device industry with specific emphasis on orthopedic products. The Vistek acquisition is highly complementary with GEMcity's current medical business and provides additional capability that is also applicable to its defense and industrial segments.

Finally, in June, Tegra Medical has acquired a manufacturing operation in San Jose, Costa Rica from Penn United Technologies, Inc., a diversified manufacturer of metal components and assemblies. Costa Rica has a rapidly developing medical device manufacturing industry. This facility is highly strategic to Tegra and will allow the company to more fully support its medical device OEM customers.
